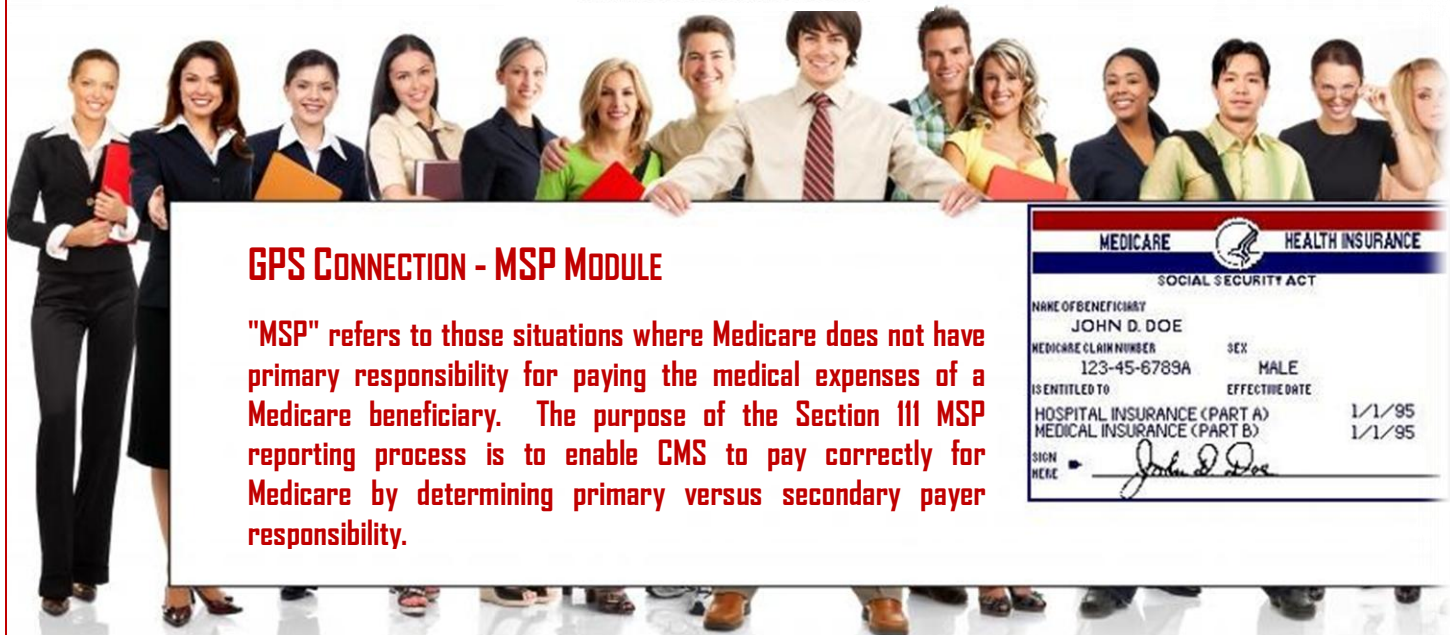

## **GPS CONNECTION - MSP MODULE**

"MSP" refers to those situations where Medicare does not have primary responsibility for paying the medical expenses of a Medicare beneficiary. The purpose of the Section III MSP reporting process is to enable CMS to pay correctly for Medicare by determining primary versus secondary payer responsibility.

Section III MSP reporting is mandatory for insurance companies and TPAs that pay claims. However, plan sponsors who pay their own group health plan's claims become the Responsible Reporting Entity (RRE) and assume the responsibility of reporting themselves.
